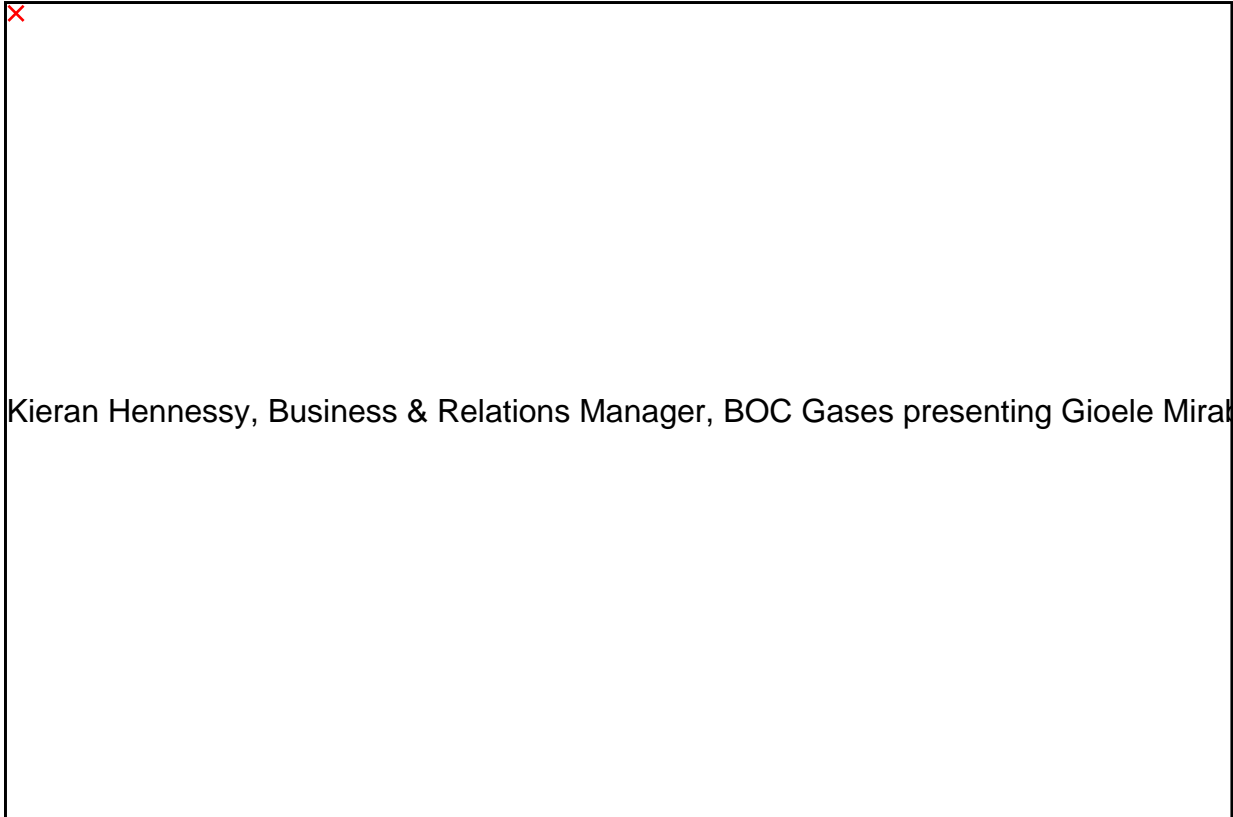




BOC Gases Bursary Award 2019 Winner Gioele Mirabelli
